The schooner Lively was Stephen F. Austin's first effort to bring settlers and supplies to his Colony. The Lively left New Orleans on November 23, 1821 intending to meet Austin at the mouth of the Colorado. The supplies needed for the new Colony and about 20 colonists were onboard. After a difficult month-long trip that included passing by both the Brazos and the Colorado, the Lively dropped the settlers and some of the supplies off at the mouth of the Brazos.
